

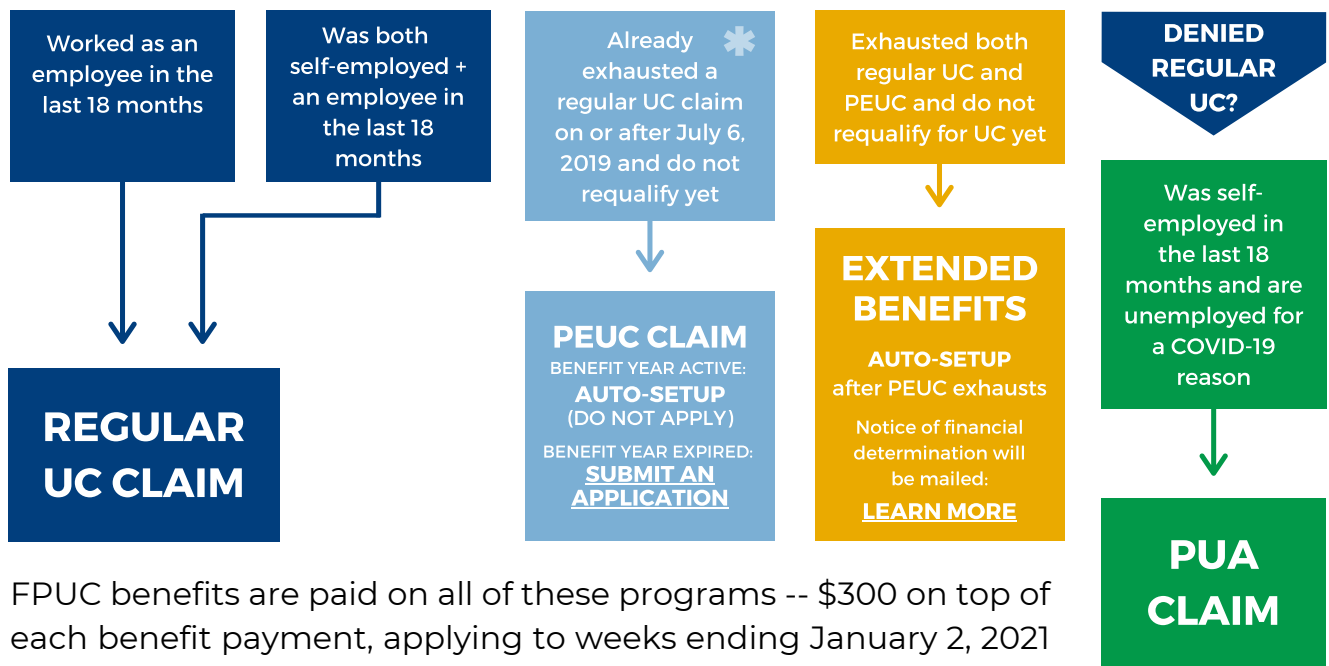


# Unemployment Programs

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW & DO

“Unemployed” means you have less or no work being offered to you, or if self-employed, you do not have as much business and are therefore not working as much as you were.

### Which UC program should you file for?



FPUC benefits are paid on all of these programs -- \$300 on top of each benefit payment, applying to weeks ending January 2, 2021 through the week ending March 13, 2021.

\* For individuals owning an “S-Corp,” you are self-employed only if you are a corporate officer of your S-Corp. This means you own the company, provide direction and control to the S-Corp, and are considered to be the corporate officer. If you are part of an S-Corp but are not the corporate officer, you are considered a regular employee and would file for regular UC.
