




Unemployment Programs

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW & DO

“Unemployed” means you have less or no work being offered to you, or if self-employed, you do not have as much business and are therefore not working as much as you were.

Which UC program should you file for?



FPUC benefits are paid on all of these programs -- \$300 on top of each benefit payment, applying to weeks ending January 2, 2021 through the week ending September 4, 2021.

MEUC benefits are paid to eligible regular UC, PEUC, or EB claimants with a self-employment history -- \$100 on top of each benefit payment, applying to weeks ending January 2, 2021 through the week ending September 4, 2021.

* For individuals owning an “S-Corp,” you are self-employed only if you are a corporate officer of your S-Corp. This means you own the company, provide direction and control to the S-Corp, and are considered to be the corporate officer. If you are part of an S-Corp but are not the corporate officer, you are considered a regular employee and would file for regular UC.
